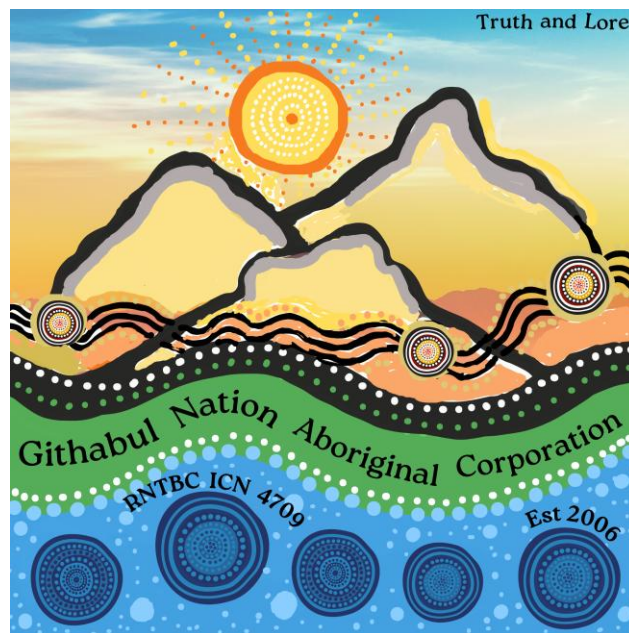




OFFICIAL LOGO MEANING

GITHABUL NATION ABORIGINAL CORPORATION LOGO

This document records the cultural meaning and interpretation of the Githabul Nation Aboriginal Corporation logo as described and provided by Bev Garces.

The Meaning of the Logo

The logo represents our continuing connection to Country, culture, ancestors, songlines and the stories carried through generations.

The three mountains represent the Three Brothers — Julgalbunj -Mount Lindesay, Wollumbin- Mount Warning and barhnam- Mount Barney. These mountains are significant to our connection to Country and to our Githabul identity.

The Mt. Lindesay Song, sung by my great-grandfather, Alec Bond, is an important part of our family's connection to the Three Brothers mountains and the cultural knowledge carried through generations. The song and the mountains represent a living connection between our ancestors, Country and those of us who continue to carry this knowledge today.

The sun and sunset represent the continuing journey of our people, the passing of knowledge through generations and the ongoing connection between Country, ancestors and future generations.

The river represents the waterways of Country and the life and connection they provide. Together with the mountains and rainforest, it reflects who we are as Githabul people.

WE ARE THE MOUNTAIN, RIVER AND RAINFOREST PEOPLE.

The Githabul Dreamtime songline from Byron Bay continuing westward represents the connection between places, Country, story and the journeys of our ancestors. These connections are not separate; they form part of the continuing Githabul story.

The logo brings these elements together as a visual representation of Githabul Country, identity, ancestral knowledge, song, story and our continuing responsibility to carry culture forward for future generations. It also recognises the Muli Muli football club colours of black, green and white which I had the privilege of designing their apparel.

Cultural Interpretation & Authorship

The cultural interpretation and meaning contained in this document have been developed and provided by Bev Garces, based on the cultural knowledge, family connection and meaning attributed to the logo.

This statement is intended to accompany the Githabul Nation Aboriginal Corporation logo as an explanation of its cultural elements and significance.
